

End Semester Examinations (ESE), May 2019

RESULT NOTIFICATION

BSc 2nd, 4th & 6th Semesters (Old Course)

The provisional results of the End Semester Examinations, May 2019, for BSc 2nd, 4th & 6th Semesters (Old Course) are hereby declared.

Issue of mark sheets

1. Mark sheets will be issued from the college exam branch from 25 June 2019 onwards during office hours.
2. For students who have been declared passed in BSc having cleared all six semesters, Provisional Pass Certificates are being issued by the college. Each student has to pay ₹200/- (Rupees two hundred only) using ATM/Debit/Credit card at the college exam branch counter for the original Degree Pass Certificate from the university.

Correction of mark sheet

While all possible care has been taken to ensure accuracy in the results published, errors, if any, will be rectified as per the examination rules and regulations of the college. Any mistake in the mark sheet must be reported to the college exam branch before 25 July 2019, after which due fees will be charged for any necessary correction.


Revaluation

1. Revaluation of answer books in any number of papers is permitted.
2. The fee for revaluation is ₹500/- per answer book.
3. The filled-in application form and prescribed fee should be submitted along with original copies of the mark sheet to the college exam branch before 10 July 2019.

Papers not cleared in BSc (Old Course)

1. BSc students registered in 2012 and before have exhausted the maximum period prescribed for completion of the programme. No more chances of appearing in examinations will be given to them.
2. BSc students registered in 2013 who have not completed the programme have exhausted the maximum period prescribed for completion of even semester papers. They can apply to clear odd semester arrears in End Semester Examinations, November 2019, after which the maximum period will be exhausted.
3. BSc students registered in 2014 who have not completed the programme can apply to clear even semester arrears in End Semester Examinations, May 2020, and odd semester arrears in End Semester Examinations, November 2020, after which the maximum period will be exhausted.
